

COOKIE POLICY

This document explains what you need to know about how Langdale House uses cookies on its website, and how to choose to manage or remove them if you wish to do so.

A cookie is a small piece of data sent from a website and stored on your computer or mobile phone when you visit a website. They are helpful because they help to make a website work better for a user.

Our Cookies

Google Analytics

We use Google Analytics on our website to show us useful statistics about the number of visitors using our website. Google Analytics sets is own cookies which enable the service to work. Cookie Notice

This cookie is used to record if a user has seen and closed the cookie notice we show on our website. This prevents it being shown to people who have already seen it (If you delete your cookies and come back to this website you will see the notice again).

Preventing the use of Cookies
